APPENDIX C
RENEWABLE ENERGY CERTIFICATES**

RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS

Availability

Renewable energy, through the *Enviro-Watts program*, is available to all residential class consumers on rate schedules RSR, RFR, and RTOU. It is for the purchase of energy from renewable resources and to support qualified environmental organizations.

Rate

In addition to the total charges determined under the applicable rate schedule, the Renewable Energy Certificates will be available to residential class accounts for a minimum of \$1.00 per 100 kWh. REC's must be purchased in blocks of 100 kWh and a maximum of ten 100 kWh blocks may be purchased per month.

Terms of Agreement

Consumers will enter into a 12 month agreement with Johnson County REMC for the number of REC kWh blocks purchased per month. This agreement is a requirement of participation in the program. Prices and purchase commitments are subject to change on an annual basis. Consumers who opt to purchase during one 12 month period are not obligated in any future 12 month period, and may change purchase quantities on an annual basis.

COMMERCIAL & INDUSTRIAL CUSTOMERS

Availability

Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) are available to all commercial and industrial class consumers on rate schedules SPC, MPC, LPS, LTOU, GDS, and IPT. RECs will be purchased and retired on behalf of customers who choose to purchase the product. Buyers will be provided with documentation from a certification firm confirming the RECs are from a renewable resource and information about the location and type of renewable resources that support the acquired RECs. Effort will be made to purchase certified RECs from Indiana resources but credits may be sourced from out-of-state locations.

Rate

In addition to the total charges determined under the applicable rate schedule, the Renewable Energy Certificates will be available to commercial class accounts for a minimum of \$10.00 per 1,000 kWh. REC's must be purchased in blocks of 1,000 kWh. Limits to the number of purchases will be dependent on availability of the renewable resources.

Terms of Agreement

An agreement must be executed by December 1 of the current year for participation in the following calendar year's program. Consumers will enter into a yearly agreement with Johnson County REMC for the number of REC kWh blocks purchased per month. This agreement is a requirement of participation in the program. Prices and purchase commitments are subject to change on an annual basis. Consumers who opt to purchase during one calendar year period are not obligated in any future calendar year, and may change purchase quantities on an annual basis.
